Sign of Peace	<i>Priest:</i> The peace of the Lord be with you always. <i>People:</i> And also with you.	<i>Priest:</i> The peace of the Lord be with you always. <i>People:</i> And with your spirit.	Rev 19:9 Lk 7:6-7 Mt 8:8
<i>Ecce Agnus Dei</i>	<i>Priest:</i> This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are those who are called to his supper. <i>All:</i> Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed.	<i>Priest:</i> Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb. <i>All:</i> Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.	
Concluding Rites	<i>Priest:</i> The Lord be with you. <i>People:</i> And also with you.	<i>Priest:</i> The Lord be with you. <i>People:</i> And with your spirit.

Go in the peace of Christ.	Go forth, the Mass is ended.
<i>Or:</i> The Mass is ended, go in peace.	<i>Or:</i> Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord.
<i>Or:</i> Go in peace to love and serve the Lord.	<i>Or:</i> Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life.
	<i>Or:</i> Go in peace.
